Below is a description of the CST Program offered at Sokaogon Chippewa Family Services. If you know a child that may benefit from the CST Program, please contact Sokaogon Chippewa CST.

The CST Program uses a wraparound approach in assisting qualifying children who have behavioral health issues at home, school, or in their community. Wraparound is a process used to build a team of supports for children and their family. The CST Coordinator will assist the child and family with connecting to resources, building their team, and identifying needs, strengths, and goals. Then the CST Coordinator and the team will help the child and family with reaching their goals and needs. These team members can be anyone the child and family feel are supportive of their needs.

The family's team reviews a summary of the child and family's needs, strengths, and goals and together develops an individualized plan of care. It's a problem solving process along with a supportive group for the child and family.

Eligibility:

CST is for youth ages 3-17 years old who live on the Sokaogon Chippewa Reservation or are a Sokaogon Chippewa Tribal Member who lives within a 25-mile radius of the Sokaogon Chippewa Reservation and are:

 Involved in 2 or more systems of care - Mental Health, AODA, Juvenile Justice, Special Education/IEP, or Child Protective Services
